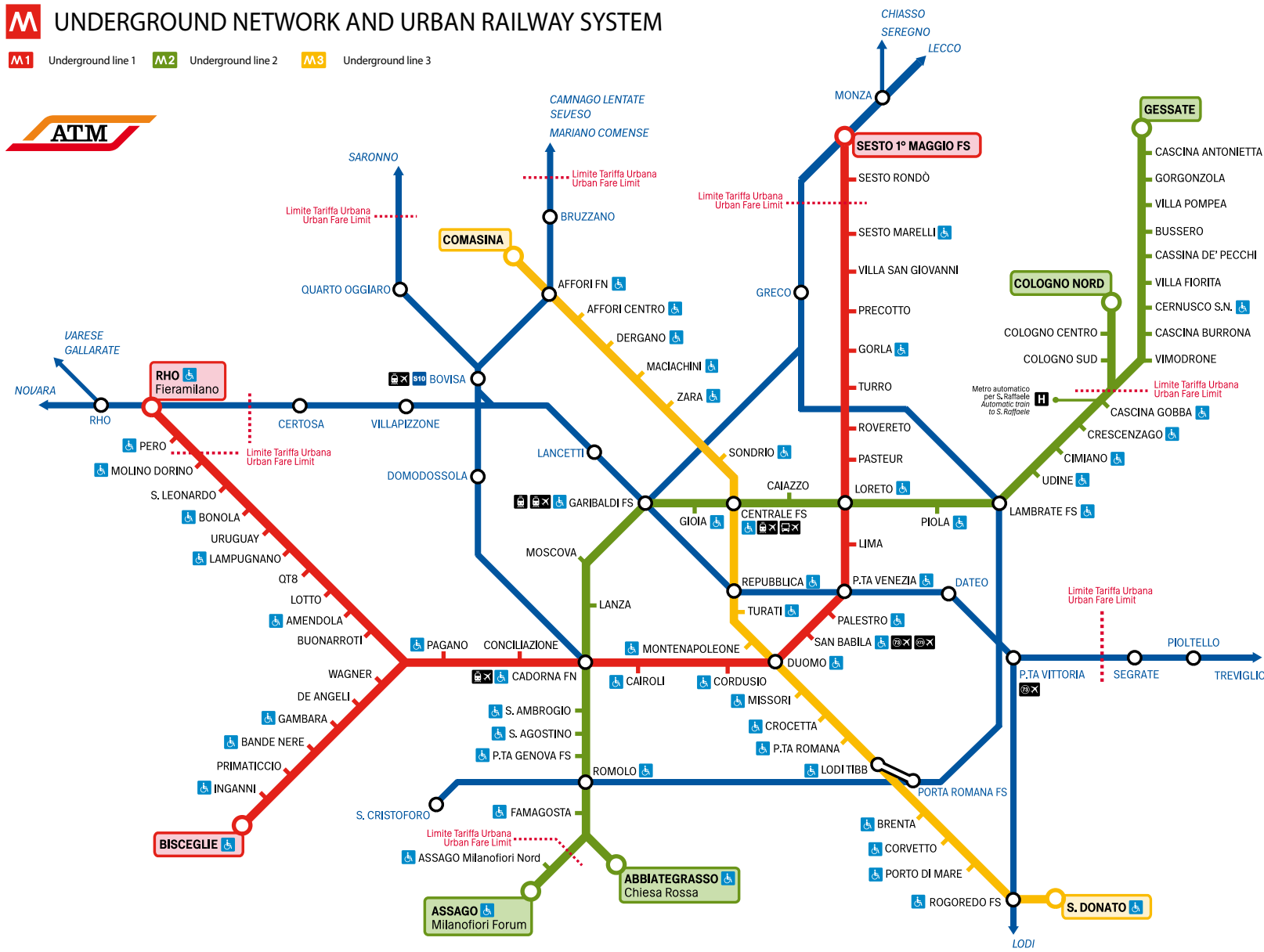

## Transportation

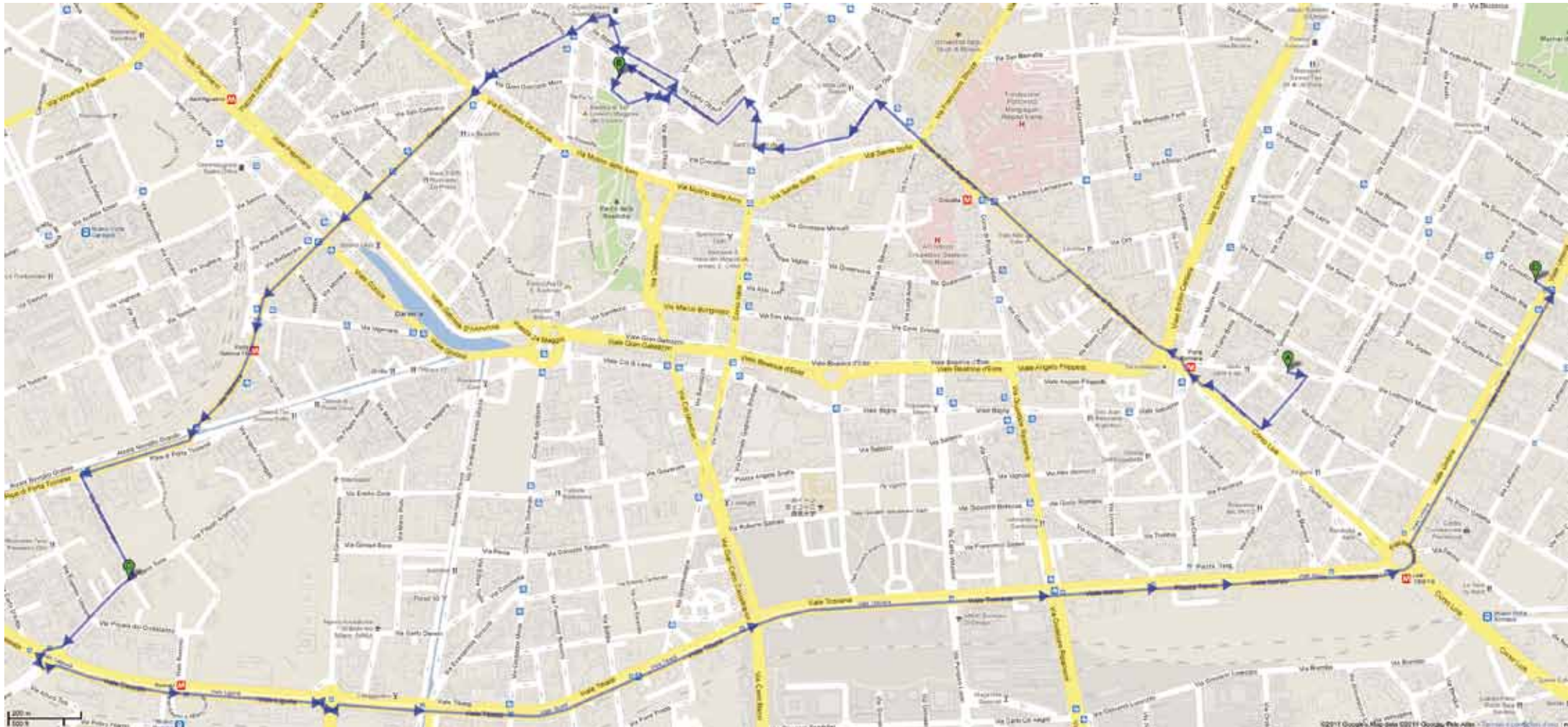
**ATM (Azienda Trasporti Milanesi)** manages the public transport service of the city of Milan. It provides underground train, urban tramway, inter-urban tramway, urban bus and trolley bus, interurban bus and airport transfer services.

**Metro services operate between 06:00-24:00** and cover three lines.

After midnight, a night-time bus service substitutes for lines 1 and 3 of the underground.

There are numerous tram routes that cover Milan, generally trams run from 06:00-24:00.

However, routes 4, 5, 7, 11, 15, 19, 23, 24, 29, 30, 33 continue until about 02:00 on weekdays.
