Select the verse or parts of verse with cursor and a box appears allowing you to highlight from four different colors.

Search by Word or Phrase

Click Magnifying Glass icon on top right of Google Books Viewer and type word or phrase *within quotation marks* to search. E.g. "righteous man" or "good man".

Post Notes

Select verse or part of verse and a box appears allowing you to 'Add Note'.

Retrieve note by placing cursor above highlighted text or clicking 'Contents' icon on top right of Google Books Viewer and clicking 'Notes' to view all saved notes.

Increase Text Size

Click 'Aa' icon on top right of Google Books Viewer to increase or decrease text size.

Add Bookmarks

[3] I beseech thee, O LORD, remember now how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore.

[4] And it came to pass, afore Isaiah was gone out into the middle court, that the word of the LORD came to him, saying,

[5] Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will heal thee: on the third day thou shalt go up unto the house of the LORD.

[6] And I will add unto thy days fifteen years; and I will deliver thee and

[23] The fear of the LORD tendeth to life: and he that hath it shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.

Proverbs 14

[27] The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

Psalms 85
