# ORDER MCRAE FIRE PLANNING AREA CLOSURE KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551,and 36 CFR § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands within the Tusayan Ranger District, Kaibab National Forest, in Coconino County within the state of Arizona. The closure area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

# **PROHIBITIONS:**

- 1. Going into or being upon the McRae Fire Planning Area; 36 CFR §261.52(e).
- 2. Being on a road within the McRae Fire Planning Area; 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

# **EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force or other authorized personnel in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with a written permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.
- 3. Authorized personnel from Energy Resources Inc. accessing the Canyon Uranium Mine on Forest Road 305AB.

# MCRAE FIRE PLANNING AREA CLOSURE AREA DESCRIPTION:

National Forest System lands bounded to the east by Forest Service Road (FSR) 2725, to the south by FSR 305, to the west by US Highway 64 and to the north by FSR 688.

Roads within the Closure Area include:

Forest Road 305AH Forest Road 305A Forest Road 305AC Forest Road 305AB Forest Road 2703 Forest Road 2703A Forest Road 305AD Forest Road 308

# **PURPOSE:**

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to high fire danger.

- 1. This Order becomes effective at 8:00 a.m., July 18, 2014 and will remain in force until rescinded or until August 15, 2014, which event ever occurs first.
- 2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed in Exhibit A.




Exhibit A: McRae Fire Planning Area Closure Area.
