

North Kaibab Ranger District Personal-Use Fuelwood Cutting Season Ends Nov. 30


FREDONIA, Ariz. – The North Kaibab Ranger District would like to remind residents that the 2014 Personal Use Fuelwood Cutting Season ends on November 30, 2014. All unused fuelwood cutting permits will not be valid afterward.

Permits are issued for dead and down (dead standing and downed trees) fuelwood cutting for all species. Permits are \$5 per cord, with a four-cord minimum and 10-cord maximum purchase, and are available for purchase from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday at the North Kaibab Ranger District Office located at 430 S. Main St., Fredonia, AZ. 86022.


The district will resume the sale of wood cutting permits for the 2015 season in May 2015, pending appropriate weather conditions. 
A standard, full cord of wood is a volume of 128 cubic feet, which measures 8 feet long by 4 feet high by 4 feet wide. A full cord can weigh up to 5,000 pounds.



Standard 1-ton truck beds with high racks holds approximately 1 1/2 (one and a half) cords of wood. Six tickets required.



A 1/4-ton & 1/2-ton pickup short-bed truck beds hold approximately 1/2 (one-half) cord of wood. Two tickets required.



A 1/2 or 3/4 ton long-bed truck beds hold approximately 1/2 (one-half) cord of wood. One load ticket required. With racks this truck bed holds approximately 1 (one) cord of wood. Four tickets required.
