Forest Service To Host Workshop on Applying for Jobs

FLAGSTAFF, Ariz. – The Kaibab and Coconino National Forests are offering a workshop Jan. 26 at 5:30 p.m. on the Northern Arizona University campus in order to provide information on available Forest Service jobs and how to apply for them.
